



L5 is a two-day program designed for those who want to study Behavioral Governance. This is a new body of research that examines how leadership, stewardship, and governance impact the quality of a fiduciary standard. The Behavioral Governance framework developed through the L5 is universal in application and can be employed in any leadership role.
